FELINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA (FIA)

- Feline Infectious Anemia affects cats of all ages and is caused by multiple microorganisms.
- Can be transferred to kittens at birth as well as through bite wounds, but mostly through fleas and ticks
- Prevention is the best way to fight this disease - "If you don't prevent it, they're gonna get it" in Guam.
- Flea and tick control and keeping cats indoors will help prevent exposure to this disease
- Keeping indoors does not help much!

FELINE IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (FIV)

- Is similar to HIV in humans and causes immunosuppression Spread through bites, sexual contact, and at birth; it is not transmitted through casual contact.
- There is currently no safe vaccine to prevent FIV. The best prevention is to keep your cat indoors.
- It is NOT contagious to people.

Feline Leukemia (FELV)

- Affects the white blood cells and impairs the immune system Often called the "friendly cat" disease as it can spread just by being in close contact
- Prevention is key- vaccinate cats against this disease
 - **VACCINATION IS THE KEY!**
