

# WHAT HAPPENS AFTER VACCINATIONS?



It's common for pets to experience mild, short-lasting side effects after receiving a vaccine, typically starting within hours and subsiding within 24 hours. You may notice signs such as tenderness and swelling at the injection site or tiredness.

However, if severe side effects like facial swelling or difficulty breathing occur within two hours of vaccination, this may indicate an allergic reaction, and **immediate veterinary care is necessary**.

## COMMON SIDE EFFECTS:

- Discomfort or swelling at the vaccination site
- Mild fever
- Decreased appetite and activity



Let your vet know about any past reactions your pet has had to vaccines or medications. If you're worried about an allergic reaction, stay at the clinic for 30-60 minutes after the vaccination.

## SEEK IMMEDIATE VETERINARY CARE IF YOU OBSERVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SIGNS AFTER VACCINATION:

- Persistent vomiting and diarrhea
- Hives
- Swelling around the face, neck, or eyes
- Coughing or difficulty breathing
