
WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- Pre-anesthetic meds, antibiotics, and pain relief
- Anesthesia monitoring
- Vital sign monitoring
- Ear cleaning + Nail Grind
- 1 free night hospitalization
- 2 meals + 4 walks daily
- Dissolvable stitches (*some may need removal*)
- Post-op care by certified vet nurses
- Laser therapy for faster healing and less pain



WHY SPAY & NEUTER?

- Reduces roaming and aggression
- Lowers cancer risks
- Decreases spraying and marking
- Increases lifespan by 3-5 years
- Prevents unwanted litters
- Eliminates emergency pyometra treatment



Pre-Surgery Requirements



Vaccinations

Proof of core vaccinations required. Without proof, your pet will need a vaccine package including exam, deworming, parasite screening, nail trim, ear cleaning & vaccines.



Flea & Tick Prevention

Current prevention required. If not provided, prevention will be applied upon arrival.



Age-Based Bloodwork

Required for pets 1+ years old. Helps detect problems not apparent during physical exams. Tests vary by age and species.

SURGERY DROP OFF:

- Drop off your pet the night before surgery
- You're welcome to bring their belongings (blanket, toy, or favorite food)
- Check-in includes signing forms and confirming details
- A deposit is required when booking the surgery

Important:



Cats must be in carriers



Dogs must be on a collar and leash or in a carrier

Preparing Your Pet for Veterinary Procedures: What You Need to Know

Recommended Tests by Age

- At 1 Year Old
 - Dogs: Flex4 blood test (heartworm & tick disease)
 - Cats: FELV (Feline Leukemia) and FIV (Feline Immunodeficiency) tests
- At 3+ Years Old
 - Dogs: Flex4 test (heartworm & tick disease) + CBC
 - Cats: FELV/FIV test + CBC (Complete Blood Count) to check for infections and anemia
- At 7+ Years Old
 - Dogs & Cats: Full bloodwork including Flex4 or FELV/FIV, CBC, and Comprehensive Diagnostics testing to check kidney and liver health, electrolytes, diabetes, and more

What These Tests Do

- **Flex4:** Helps find illnesses like heartworm or tick diseases (dogs)
- **FELV/FIV:** Finds serious viral infections (cats)
- **CBC:** Checks for infections and anemia
- **Comprehensive Diagnostic:** Checks organ and metabolic health



Optional Services

(Not included in the cost of surgery)

These add-on services help support your pets safety, comfort, and long-term health during and after surgery.



IV Fluid Therapy

- Helps prevent **dehydration, low blood pressure,** and **anesthesia-related complications.**
- **Required for all pets over 7 years old.**



Additional Pain Medication

- Every pet reacts to surgery differently—some need **extra pain relief** after their procedure.
- Keeps your pet more comfortable during recovery.



Microchip Identification

- A permanent form of ID to help **reunite lost pets** with their families.
- Registered and scannable at most veterinary clinics and shelters.



E-Collar Protection

- Stops your pet from **licking or chewing the incision site.**
- Protects against infection and damage to the surgery area while it heals.
